

- School violence researchers/academics

 protective of student privacy and ensuring that students are not discriminated against on the
 basis of race, national origin, disability, religion, or sex

Consultation Must Ask

Each application must be accompanied by an assurance that the application was prepared after consultation with individuals such as:

- · What gaps are there in current school safety planning efforts?
- How will the resources requested be effectively integrated into other comprehensive school safety and climate planning efforts taking place in the district?
- How will acquired technology be aligned strategically and protect students' civil and privacy rights?
- · In the past, what evidence-based strategies and programs has the district implemented?
- · Can you compare/contrast any prior unsuccessful attempts to improve security measures?
- Explain why the proposed measures have a strong likelihood of success.
- Explain efforts to avoid criminalizing school conduct that should be handled through the school discipline process.
